





Amangani (peaceful home) clings to the crest of East Gros Ventre Butte, some 7,000 feet (2,135 metres) above sea level, high above the town of Jackson, Wyoming. The 40-suite retreat is a year-round destination acting as a premier ski resort from December through March, and the ideal base for exploring the magnificent natural surroundings in the warmer months.

With its floor-to-ceiling columns of Oklahoma sandstone, ceilings and walls in Pacific redwood and chairs of rattan and woven cowhide, Amangani embraces the spirit of the West.



The Lounge, with its soaring redwood ceiling, two large wood-burning fireplaces and two-storey window wall, affords open views across to the Snake River Range and below to Spring Gulch.





Located next to the Lounge, the Library is a comfortable, light-filled room (*above right*). A selection of books on Western and Native American culture, as well as the region's flora and fauna, is available. CDs, DVDs and games may be borrowed by guests.



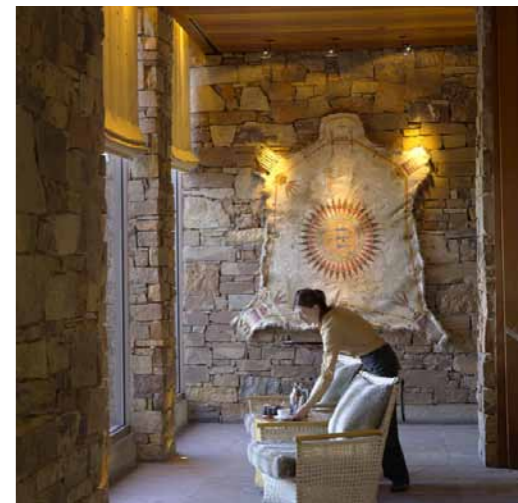
The adjacent Takoda Room (*left*), furnished with a wood-burning fireplace, is available for meetings and special-occasion dining.



Terrazzo tables, metal-sculpted elk art and a wood-burning fireplace, lend a distinctive ambience to The Grill, Amangani's 65-seat dining room which is open for breakfast, lunch and dinner.



The Zinc Bar is an ideal venue for casual refreshments throughout the day.





Each suite includes a king-size platform bed, fireplace, window-side day bed, terrazzo dining table, woven cowhide chairs in faux wolf fabric and a pine-stump table. Walls are decorated with back-lit cedar planks. The large bathroom and dressing area features a deep-soaking tub, twin vanities and a shower room trimmed in slate. Floors are finished in clear-heart redwood.



The Spring Gulch Suite (*right*) covers 676 square feet (63 square metres) and offers a large terrace with spectacular views. This suite is situated at the highest level of the resort. The Grand Teton Suite (*above*) features a spacious balcony with magnificent views of the Grand Teton mountain range.





Only a 20-minute complimentary drive from Amangani, the vast and varied ski terrain of Jackson Hole's Rendezvous and Après Vous mountains is suited to skiers of all levels.



Conveniently located just below Jackson Hole Mountain Resort's Bridger Gondola, at the base of Rendezvous Mountain, Amangani's private Ski Lounge provides easy access to some of America's finest ski slopes.



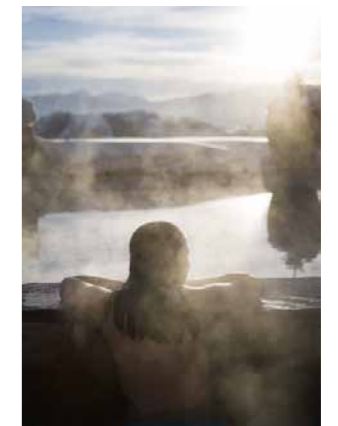


In winter Jackson Hole becomes a snow-covered playground. Guests can ski and snowboard to their heart's content as well as enjoying dog-sledding, sleigh rides, snowmobiling, snow-shoeing and ice skating. A 10-minute drive from Amangani, the town of Jackson offers warmer entertainment in the form of museums, art galleries and boutiques.



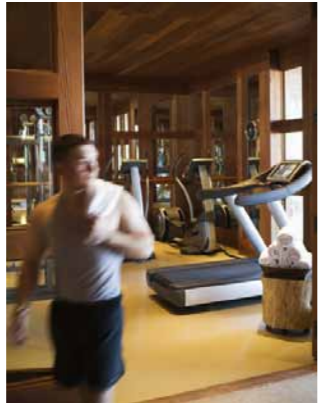


The 115-foot (35-metre) heated outdoor swimming pool is linked to a whirlpool.





The Spa and Fitness Centre features treatment rooms, exercise studios, separate steam rooms and individualised yoga programmes. Other resort facilities include the Gallery, where local art, jewellery and antiques can be purchased.





Amangani's accommodation options include 29 Suites, five Deluxe Suites, the Shoshone Suite, two Amangani Suites, the Sena Suite, the Grand Teton Suite, the Spring Gulch Suite and the Amangani Homes.



Floor-to-ceiling windows offer some of the most spectacular panoramas in Jackson Hole. Guests staying in the Homes enjoy all of Amangani's services, from house-keeping to catered dining, as well as full use of Amangani's award-winning facilities.





A year-round destination, Jackson Hole is known for its skiing but offers a multitude of activities in spring, summer and fall. These include hiking, horseback riding, fly-fishing, river trips and hot air ballooning. Elk, bison, bighorn sheep, mule deer and the occasional moose and pronghorn may be sighted on four-wheel-drive safaris.
